3. God, by Your Name deliver me, and judge [vindicate] me by Your might.

ד אֱלֹקִים שְׁמַע תְּפִלָּתִי הֲאִזִּינָה לְאִמְרֵי־פִי:

4. God, hear my prayer; listen to the words of my mouth.

ה כִּי זָרִים | קָמוּ עָלַי וְעָרִיצִים בִּקְשׂוּ נַפְשִׁי לֹא שָׂמוּ אֱלֹקִים לְנִגְדָם סְלָה:

5. For strangers have risen up against me, and violent men have sought my soul; they have not set God before them, Selah.

ו הִנֵּה אֱלֹקִים עֹזֵר לִי אֲדֹנָי־י בְּסִמְכֵי נַפְשִׁי:

6. Behold, God is my helper; my Master is with those who support my soul.

ז יָשׁוּב [יָשִׁיב] הָרַע לְשָׂרְרֵי בְּאִמְתָּךְ הַצְּמִיתֵם:

*Please do not discard this holy document. Please deposit in Geniza at your local synagogue.*

7. He will repay the evil to those who watch for my downfall with Your truth destroy them.

ח בְּנִדְבָה אִזְבַּחַה-לָךְ אֹדָה שְׂמֵךְ ד' כִּי-טוֹב:

8. With a free will offering will I sacrifice to You; I will thank Your Name, Adoniye, for it is good.

ט כִּי מִכָּל-צָרָה הִצִּילֵנִי וּבְאֵיבֵי רְאֵתָה עֵינַי:

9. For from all trouble He has rescued me, and upon my enemies [downfall] has my eye gazed.
