1. To the Chief Musician, on yedootoon, a Psalm of David.

ב אֵךְ אֶל־אֱלֹקִים דְּוַמִּיָּה נַפְשִׁי מְמַנּוּ יְשׁוּעָתִי:

2. Only for God my soul waits in silence, from Him comes my deliverance.

ג אֵךְ־הוּא צוּרִי וְיְשׁוּעָתִי מְשַׁנְּבִי לֹא־אֲמוּט רַבָּה:

3. Only He is my rock and my deliverance; my stronghold, I will not be moved greatly.

ד עַד־אָנָּה | תְּהוֹתֶנּוּ עַל־אִישׁ תִּרְצָחוּ כְּלַכֶּם פְּקִיר נְטוּי גֹדֵר הַדְּחוּיָה:

4. How long will you plan destruction against man, that you may slay him as a leaning wall, a tottering fence?

ה אֵךְ מְשִׂאתוֹ | יַעֲצוּ לְהַדִּיחַ יָרְצוּ כָזָב בְּפִיו יְבָרְכוּ וּבְקִרְבָּם יִקְלְלוּ־סֵלָה:

5. Only [because they fear] his lofty position have they plotted to topple him; delighting in lies, with their mouth they bless [him], but inwardly they curse [him], Selah.

6. Only for God my soul wait silently, for my hope comes from Him.

ז אֶדְ-הוּא צוֹרִי וַיְשׁוּעָתִי מִשְׁנֵבִי לֹא אָמוּט:

7. He alone is my rock and my deliverance; my stronghold, I will not be moved.

ח עַל-אֱלֹקִים יִשְׁעֵי וְכְבוֹדֵי צוֹר-עֵזִי מַחְסֵי בְּאֱלֹקִים:

8. Upon God [rests] my deliverance and my honor, the rock of my strength, my refuge is in God.

ט בְּטַחּוֹ בּוֹ בְּכָל-עֵת | עִם שְׂפִכּוֹ לְפָנָיו לְבַבְכֶם אֱלֹקִים מַחְסֵה-לָנוּ סֵלָה:

9. Trust in Him at all times, people; pour out your hearts before Him, God is a refuge for us, Selah.

י אֶדְ הַבֵּל בְּנֵי-אָדָם כְּזָב בְּנֵי אִישׁ בְּמֵאזְנִים לַעֲלוֹת הֵמָּה מֵהַבֵּל יַחַד:

10. But the sons of man are as nothing and deceitful are men of distinction! [If laid] on the scales, they and their vanity would be equal.

11. Trust not in oppression, and in robbery do not put vain hope; if [illegal] wealth prospers let your heart pay it no need.

12. Once has God spoken, twice have I heard this; that strength belongs to God.
